KILKENNY GAA aims to provide a safe environment for all our players. We commit to following the guidance set out in the GAEILIC GAMES ASSOCIATION CHILD SAFEGUARDING POLICY STATEMENT in relation to all activities involving people under 18 years of age. We also commit to advising and supporting clubs to follow these guidelines.

We understand that this Code applies to all persons under 18 years of age who participate in our games or other activities and to those who work with them and assist them in any capacity on our behalf.

ALLEGED BREACHES OF THE CODE OF BEHAVIOUR (UNDERAGE)

Kilkenny GAA will follow the guidance provided by the *CHILD SAFEGUARDING POLICY* (Section 4) in relations to alleged breaches of the code of behaviour (underage). Breaches of the Code, whether by an adult or a child, will be addressed in a proportionate manner and should a sanction ever be required, following a breach of the Code, it should be applied in accordance with the provisions of the Code, as outlined for that purpose.
