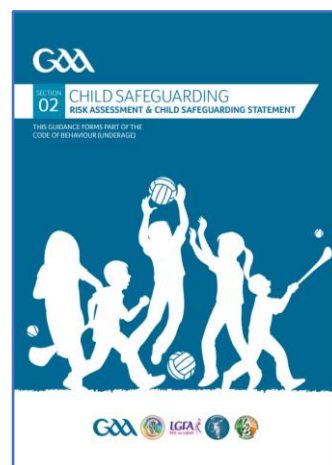
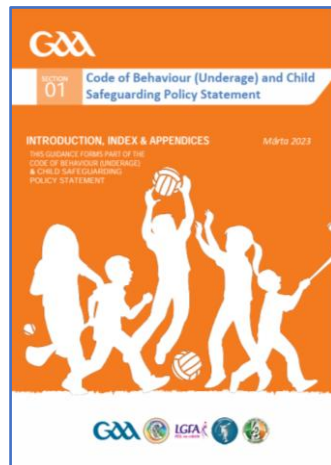
CHILD SAFEGUARDING POLICY.
